**Footnotes**

DANCE PRO stalked the early pace in hand, was pushed out six wide into the stretch then outdueled BOASTFUL through a long drive. BOASTFUL raced boxed behind the first flight for five furlongs, pushed his way out five wide out of the second turn to gain clear racing room, dueled through a long drive then just hung late while best of the rest. AWESOME CANNONBALL was void of early speed, made a middle move to contention to be in striking distance into the furlong grounds along the inside but failed to sustain that rally late. DOCTOR TURKO made a middle move to also be in striking distance after six furlongs then weakened under pressure. INDIA SUN dueled for six furlongs then gave way. EL SOPRANO passed tiring rivals. SAY IT ISN'T SOLD vied for the lead for six furlongs then faded. FIREY NEW LOVE was hard used disputing the issue into the stretch then faltered late. GWAIHIR (IRE) was through after a half. SERIOUS ALERT showed little.
