TOASTMASTER chased the leader early, bid leaving the turn then drew off smartly late. CLOUT was bumped at the break, made a middle move through the turn then was up for the place late. TIEMPO LIBRE was well placed but failed to gain after a half. EVOLUTION ROCKS set a solid pace for a half then slowly weakened. FLETCHER lodged a mild rally late. CELTIC CITY failed to threaten. JEWELIAN 'N ROSES was through after a half. PEGASUS HELLAS showed little. SCHOOL BOY HEART was through early. DOWN FORCE was no factor. BORN ON DERBY DAY showed little. CASTIEL trailed.
