LEGGY LAURA stalked the pace early, bid three wide after five furlongs then shook off SUMMER AT SUSAN'S leaving the furlong grounds to draw off late. SUMMER AT SUSAN'S bid four wide in company with the winner leaving the second turn, weakened in the final furlong but was second best. DANCING RAKHA set a slow pace for five furlongs then weakened. ROMANOVA raced evenly. MOLLY'S BEST failed to menace. SUGAH SWEET was no factor. CATTY PATTY chased to the second turn then faded. HART TRIPPIN lugged out badly.
