PARISIAN FRIEND chased early, bid in company with the winner leaving the turn then weakened in the drive. AMY'S BUDDHA raced evenly. IT'S A RAP was in tight after the break. WHEELIE FAST was no factor. LOST ONE'S HALO rushed to the early lead then came up empty after a half. TRICKY VAQUERO was no threat. BURGE HOLIDAY HUNT was through after a half. RED SKY AT DAWN trailed to late. HEAR ME stopped.
