CALIENTE LIGHT was void of early speed then lodged a mild belated bid outside. KAFLEEN was restless in the gate, made a middle move to upper stretch then flattened out. PISTOLS FLOWER chased early, moved in company with the winner through the second turn then gave way. INDIAN CREEK QUEEN was through after a half. CURSIVE failed to menace. MACON DALE was restless in the gate. MS. CIMARRON was fractious in the gate.
