RIGHT FLANKER made an inside middle move, got through along the inside to challenge for and gain a short lead after a half then continued gamely through the final furlong to outfinish MY BUDDY RICHIE. MY BUDDY RICHIE chased the early leader, bid into the stretch to vie for the lead then also continued gamely through a long drive before just hanging late and bested the rest. BELICHICK was in tight and shuffled back in the turn, recovered to split rivals into the stretch but failed to gain late. DANGEROUS GUY made a four wide middle move then flattened out. ROAD OF TRADITION passed tiring rivals. D'S DESSERT was through after a half. FIREBROOK showed little. RUBY'S RED SOCKS rushed to the lead from the outside then stopped.
