GLORY BE THY NAME raced close up early, bid three wide after a half to gain a short lead but was no match for the winner while besting the rest. BLACK CIRCLE angled to the middle of the track into the stretch but failed to gain much in the drive. TALK passed tiring rivals. CHELSEA BROOK also passed faders. INDIAN APPEAL dueled to the stretch then faded. UP POPS THE DEVIL raced evenly. ZAMBUCCA was through after a half. MISS SHASA was through early. MEEK MAN stopped.
