E PLURIBUS set a moderate pace then drifted badly into the stretch. FAVORITE KETCH was restless in the gate then broke awkwardly and failed to menace. SIN BANDERAS broke slow then closed a gap late. FABULOUS FRED was no factor. HAYATI SON chased for six furlongs then came up empty. EIKA EIKA MAN trailed.
