A LITTLE SYN broke alertly, was quickly taken back to trail for almost a half, rallied quickly on the second turn to make the lead entering the stretch, drew clear and won under mild urging. THE GREAT AGA unhurried, rallied steadily behind the winner and finished second best. SPEND YOUR RAISE was outrun into the stretch then passed tiring rivals. ROBINERA was with the pace into the stretch and flattened out. CAT N' MOUSE battled for the early lead, opened a daylight advantage down the backstretch, set the pace until the top of the stretch and stopped. HEART TO BURN duled for the early lead, was through after a half, stopped to a walk and was eased to the wire.
