COLORS BY DEBORAH was not a factor. HI LILI HI LO had speed into the stretch and flattened out. SUNDAY was always outrun. U HOOTIE showed little. GLORIOUS TIMEPIECE had brief speed and stopped. TREANOR'S LADY bore in at the start bumping with HARPIEL and showed little. DONNA JO prompted the winner for three furlongs and stopped. TODDS SPIRIT was always outrun.
