Footnotes

BUCKYS BRAT went up to duel for the lead before a quarter, assumed command and widened the balance of the trip under a brisk hand ride. MARY'R'S WINNER with the pace from the start, finished with good courage to be second best while three wide. EASTER BUTTER was bumped soon after the start, allowed to settle then had a mild late rally. JOY AND WONDER set the early pace, had speed into the stretch and weakened. MORE D'AMOUR was a factor until mid stretch and gave way. P R STAR came out soon after the start brushing with EASTER BUNNY and forcing that one over on STARLIT CITY had brief speed and gave way. STARLIT CITY bore out then in leaving the gate bumping SILVER SUNSHINE and EASTER BUTTER and was always outrun. ALICE'S MAGIC failed to reach a contending position. SILVER SUNSHINE was bumped soon after the start and trailed throughout.
