ITS ON FIRE chased the leader two wide into the stretch, responded with a burst of speed when set down, made the lead before the eighth pole and won going away. MUSIC CONDUCTOR never far back, rallied determinedly through the stretch and got up for second. WINNING WORTH broke in full stride and quickly opened a daylight lead, set the pace into the stretch then was outfinished while along the inside. TIZSATION chased the leader while along the rail into the stretch, angled off the rail nearing the three sixteenths pole then faded. EQUAL JOY found his best stride too late. JUST SMOK'N well placed, lacked a closing response. MIG ALLEY had brief speed, faded and returned bleeding from the left nostril. SKIM SCAM was outrun. BLITZ ECLIPSE bore out at the start and trailed.
