CRYPTO CREAM trailed into the turn, picked up her field while rallying along the rail, split horses in late stretch to make the lead and won going away. BUSY BONNIE bore out at the start bumping with ALICE IN WONDER, sprinted to a clear lead soon thereafter, set the pace inside the furlong marker and finished second best. RACHEL GRAPE was a sharp factor until mid stretch and finished with good courage. BEAU'S REGAL GAL had speed into the stretch and weakened. EYEDANCEEYEROMANCE failed to reach contention. NANA'S DELIGHT went up to prompt the pace after a quarter, had speed into the stretch and gave way. SPEND YOUR RAISE was outrun. ANN'S QUIET CODE bore in at the start also bumping with ALICE IN WONDER, had brief speed and flattened out. ALICE IN WONDER was bounced around between horses at the start, bid to be in contention outside going into the turn then bolted and was eased.
