GUNSIGHT MOUNTAIN was well placed early, rallied in the upper stretch and angled out, finished strongly and was up in the final strides. MOODY BRUCE was well placed early, rallied in the upper stretch, gained a clear lead in late stretch, could not hold off the winner but was second best. SINGALONGWITH BERT never far back, swung six wide in the stretch and finished willingly. LARRY LOVES MARY dueled on the lead, weakened slightly in late stretch. BRAHMS LULLABY wide early, was no threat. MARTANGO allowed to settle, failed to menace. DAN LITTLE MAN raced middle of the pack on the inside and was no threat. POR SUPUESTO dueled on the lead for three furlongs, gave way in the stretch. ANDY O was never a threat. RICHER GEAR showed little and trailed.
