EQUALWAY was away alertly and quickly set the pace, had a clear lead throughout and widened late, driving. LAZY NATHAN chased the winner, could not gain late but was second best. LIL PERFECT STORM pressed the pace three wide, lacked a late response and went evenly. LOVE OF LIFE checked repeatedly down the backside on the inside, had a mild rally in the stretch. TAP TIPY TAP well placed early, lacked a late kick and went evenly. TAX MAN SAM allowed to settle and saved ground, needed more late. SAVE N TIME wide early, improved his position while no threat. CODE RUNNER was never a threat. KEEP AN ION ME was no factor. NOTHING LIKE IT flashed brief foot and was through early. MOLINARO COMPARO well placed early, tired in the stretch. PRESSOR was outrun.
