WHY US stalked the pace three wide, rallied in the stretch, edged clear late under strong handling. CHARLIES FIRE set the pace and dueled on the lead from the inside, finished willingly and held place. HISTORICAL FACT was well placed, rallied in the upper stretch, drew even in mid stretch and was outfinished late. KELLVILLE never far back, swung wide at the top of the stretch and did not threaten. SARAYU had good position on the inside, lacked a rally. BATTLE OF T GIANTS was never a threat. POLITE COMPANY showed little and trailed.
