BABA BOOEY had speed from the start and finished with good courage. BILLION BUCK BABY raced widest of all and passed tiring rivals through the stretch. POPULAR DUDE went evenly. AMAZON RUN was a sharp threat into the stretch then weakened. HUBBERT'S PEAK had brief speed. MITEY MAX WEINBERG offered little. MARTANGO was through after a half.
