WESTERN PIRATE unhurried for a half, circled horses five wide when set down entering the stretch, sustained his rally to make the lead late and won under strong handling. PAULIANO PKWY pressed the pace while hung four wide into the stretch, made the lead near the eighth pole then could not handle the winner. GOODBYE SHARK prompted the pace between horses into the stretch, drew on near even terms for the lead at the eighth pole at which point his rider lost her whip then was outfinished. CHIMCHAR sprinted up along the rail to gain a narrow lead soon after the start, set a pressured pace into the stretch then weakened. CAN'T FIND ME reluctant to load, was fractious in the gate prior to the start, led briefly the opening quarter, was a sharp threat for a half then flattened out. NOTARIZED was no factor. RESPECT MATTERS was outrun. JANNA'S SON was hustled from the start, settled mid pack and gave way then final eighth.
