ROMA'S SOLDIER was well placed early, rallied in the upper stretch, split horses in mid stretch and drew clear under strong handling. GENERAL LAFAYETTE was unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch, drew even in mid stretch, then was outfinished. FRANKIE'S FANTASY stalked the pace, rallied in mid stretch, drew even and was out kicked late. SQUIRE WYNDHAM unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch, steadied in mid stretch while between horses, then had a late gain. GULCH POINT stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, put in his bid, then flattened out. GRIDIRON KEY contended throughout, weakened slightly late. TAKAMOSA allowed to settle, failed to menace. HAROLD'S TRIBUTE set the pace for six furlongs, weakened in the stretch. BEHRLY JUMPIN well placed for six furlongs, gave way in the stretch. THETIGERMAN was through after a half.
