REDGOOP NOCHERRIES outrun into the stretch, finished with a burst of speed and got up for second. WAVELAND JITTERBUG had speed from the start and finished with good courage. RUSH DELIVERY offered a mild bid into the stretch then leveled off. MIDNIGHT CHOO CHOO went evenly. QUEEN WEEZY broke a step slow then failed to menace. HOPE GLITTERS was no threat. WIN FOR KRISSEY had speed into the stretch then gave way. FRANK'S JOYCE was no factor. SOUTHERN SLAM chased the winner into the stretch three wide then stopped.
