PRINCE OF PAULIE rated nicely off leaders down the backstretch, moved into contention on turn while being carried out by ALWAYS ON A QUEST, moved to that one's inside and drove to the wire up the rail for the win. OVER QUALIFIED settled off early pace, moved willingly to the leaders on the turn, was carried wide and finished gamely to hold second. IRISH MIST likewise circled the leaders on the turn while being carried out and finished well. ALWAYS ON A QUEST rushed to the early lead, battled through the turn while drifting out and ran on well to the wire. CALLIDE VALLEY made steady progress. GUNSIGHT MOUNTAIN pressed pace for first quarter and weakened. STARR WEST never seriously menaced. DREW STAR was no factor.
