CUSACK rated patiently down backstretch, circled five wide on turn to assume command at top of the lane and drew off under consistent pressure. STORM THIS duelled PISTOL RULES for the lead from the inside and finished gamely while holding second. MONEYINTHECUVEE always prominent, moved to the leader at the top of the stretched and dug in to the wire. PISTOL RULES set the early fractions while dueling for lead and weakened slightly at the finish . FIREONTHEWIRE raced evenly throughout. BABA BOEY never threatened. BATCHES IS TYLER was outrun.
