ALANA ZOEY dueled with the winner until mid stretch, could not match strides late but held place. JEANNE'S HERO well placed throughout while four wide, needed more late. SILKY TAB well placed and saved ground, went evenly. OHIO VOLUNTEER allowed to settle and saved ground, did not threaten. RESULTA allowed to settle, failed to menace. T. T.'S SURPRISE was no factor. HABA HEART had brief foot and was through early. D J'S MARKS LADY had brief speed and quickly gave way.
