G L KIWI dueled on the lead while three wide, edged clear late under strong handling. SCORPIO DOG dueled for the lead while between horses, held gamely in the stretch and was second best. ALL FOR LOVE was away alertly and set the early pace, dueled from the inside, weakened in mid stretch. MATELAND CLOSE well placed and saved ground, went evenly. LITTLE SHNUCK allowed to settle, failed to menace. LUCCIROCKINBUCCI saved ground and was no threat. ELUSIVE MONSTER pressed the pace four wide for a half, then retreated. GO BY GOLD showed little and trailed.
