NATIVE BRITCHES raced in the second flight early, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, closed with a rush late and was along in time. LAZY NATHAN dueled on the early lead, gained a clear lead on the turn, remained clear in mid stretch and was caught on the wire. LARRY LOVES MARY dueled and pressed throughout, finished willingly in a good effort. DARING HABIT raced middle of the pack, lacked a rally and went evenly. ITS ON FIRE well placed for a half, gave way in the stretch. STAY IN LINE was never a threat. THE BIG RED DOG wide early, was outrun. SWEET WATER RIM flashed brief foot and was through early.
