FAST SUMMER never far back, dug in determinedly late five wide and was along in time. TABULATE always within striking distance, drew on near even terms for the lead in deep stretch and finished second best while four wide. MR. CAPOTE close up from the start, steadied between horses near the five sixteenths pole, swung wide then came on again. POR SUPUESTO was bumped by GI'S SECOND CHANCE and squeezed at the start, settled within striking distance along the inside, offered a mild bid through the stretch then lacked racing room the final sixteenth. HOBGOBLIN contested the lead until deep stretch along the rail then was outfinished. LITE LEGACY battled for the lead until deep stretch and finished with good courage. AMERICAN ALL STAR was no threat. IRON WILLFUL was no factor. GI'S SECOND CHANCE bore in at the start, went up to battle for the lead between horses, steadied on the middle of the turn then dropped out of it. SAY IT ISN'T SOLD was outrun. TOUR GUIDE TORI had brief speed . HIGH TIDE was void early speed and trailed.
