AFTERTHEBALLISOVER allowed to settle, rallied late between horses and got up for second. OHIO VOLUNTEER had speed from the start and finished with good courage. JILL'S CAT had a mild late rally while no threat. JULIE GRAY offered a mild bid on the second turn then came up empty. KAREN AD VANCE away alertly, set the pace for almost a half, was a sharp threat into the stretch then weakened. FLYINGJANNA hopped at the start and was through after a half.
