Footnotes

JUST MICHEL was forced in and brushed with IMAHONEYTOO leaving the chute, settled within striking distance while settling along the inside, angled four wide on the turn, split horses near the quarter pole, drifted out a bit engaging SOUTHBOUND KATIE just past the eighth pole and proved best in a stiff drive. SOUTHBOUND KATIE came in a bit leaving the chute, prompted the pace three wide into the stretch, made the lead before the three sixteenths pole, dug in gamely when joined by the winner and just missed. IMAHONEYTOO was brushed by the winner leaving the chute, settled close up along the rail, checked behind horses on the turn, got through at the top of the stretch then finished with good courage along the inside. SPRING CAT came in sharply leaving the chute, bid five wide on the turn then was outfinished. BUBBLE DOURBON battled for the lead along the rail into the stretch then weakened late. PATTI'S CLOWN battled for the lead between horses into the stretch then gave way late. AWARD YU was no factor. RUNAWAY JULIE was no threat. TYPICAL BRAGG was outrun.
