OUT WITH A BANG was well placed and saved ground, angled out three wide in the upper stretch, closed deternienly and finished on even terms with WIN FOR JOE GATES . WIN FOR JOE GATES set the early pace and dueled on the lead from the inside, held gamely through the stretch and finished on even terms with OUT WITH A BANG. TRIBUTE TO KELLY stalked the early pace, dueled on the lead, held well through the stretch and was outfinished late. NATIVE BRITCHES never far back, rallied in the stretch, closed willingly and was gaining late. MOUNT BREVETOR unhurried early, did not threaten. KEEP AN ION ME contended three wide for six furlongs, tired in the stretch. ROLLINRETIREDTIRES was outrun.
