STEELY DAME was never far back, rallied in the stretch on the rail, edged clear late under strong handling. CHAREDY'S GREAT was well placed and saved ground, angled out three wide in the upper stretch, rallied through the stretch and just missed. PROUD MELODY contended three wide, finished willingly and was best of the rest. SHELBY'S A PRO set the pace with a clear lead, weakened in deep stretch. JACKIE'S SISTER never far back, rallied at the quarter pole four wide, went evenly in the stretch. PRINCESS JUANITA steadied at the the three eight pole and was no threat. TATIBITATI was no factor. ANN OF CASTLEMAN had brief foot and was through early.
