WATCHIN THE VIX stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, drew clear late, driving. SAVTHELASDANCEFOME was never far back, swung wide and rallied in the stretch, closed fast and was up for place. MARTANGO pressed the early pace, gained a clear lead on the turn, was outfinished late. DARING HABIT well placed on the inside, put in a bid mid stretch, then went evenly late. SINGALONGWITH BERT well placed for a half, lacked a late response. BOCCBALL contended four wide, weakened in the lane. AXEL SWAGGER slow early, improved his position while no threat. TWO POINT FAVORITE was no factor. FORSTER HALL set the early pace and was through after a half. KING T C raced mid pack early, then gave way.
