GEORGE dueled three wide throughout, prevailed after a long battle, gamely. GETA TICKET dueled while between horses, just missed after a long drive. LAZYLou CARSON stalked the pace, rallied in the stretch on the rail, finished with courage and just missed. HOUBARA stalked the pace while between horses, finished willingly in the stretch. LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. REPRISAL raced four wide and was no threat. MITEY MAX WEINBERG slow early, was never a factor. GEODI'S GOLD allowed to settle early, had a middle move while three wide, gave way in the stretch. GRAND PERFORMER had brief foot and saved ground, quickly dropped back.
