MACUM sprinted to a clear lead quickly after the start, set the pace into the stretch then was no match for the winner. SUSIE Q DANCER races erratically from the chute, surged up along the rail and settled just behind the top two then went evenly. CATHELDA offered a mild bid on the turn then came up empty. I'LL HAVE JUSTICE was no factor. STAR OF ASPEN had brief speed. GRAND ELEGANCE was bumped at the start and through early.
