CAVIAR N CHAMPAGNE with the second flight while close up along the inside, was in tight entering the turn as BLAZING BLING dropped towards the rail, angled out to the five path on the turn, responded with a burst of speed to make the lead at the eighth pole and won as much the best under a hand ride. PAY THE MAN unhurried early, rallied between horses four wide through the stretch and finished clear for second. STARTIN SOMETHING dropped back from a good beginning then found her best stride too late outside near the middle of the racetrack. BLAZING BLING dueled for the early lead between horses, dropped back a bit before the turn, angled towards the rail, came on again in mid stretch but was outfinished. STAMP QUEEN was bumped at the start by NIGHT OF ROMA, contested the lead three wide into the turn, made the lead briefly, battled until deep stretch then weakened. AGRSSIVE ELEGANCE failed to menace. WILLA WANDO offered a mild bid four wide on the turn then came up empty. MAD JAZZ rushed to the lead along the inside, dueled until mid stretch then gave way. SIGNIFICANT BLING had speed for a half then faded. NIGHT OF ROMA broke outward bumping STAMP QUEEN

then was not a threat. PRETTY MUCH MINE had brief speed. DOUBLED VISION raced widest of all down the backstretch and was through early.
