TALES OF GLORY went straight to the lead to set a fast pace,had a clear lead through out to remain clear, driving. LOCKER stalked the pace, was well placed, was no match for the winner, but held place. ARISTOCAT was allowed to settle, rallied, in the upper stretch, to close willingly. ONE SMOOTH RIDE was slow early,had steady advance,but was no threat. JACHOVIA allowed to settle, passed tiring rivals,while being no real threat. OLMOS CREEK was in the middle of pack, and failed to menace. WEST DALLAS contended early and weakened. CAST NO SHADOW was well and placed, gave way. DAWN'S REVENGE had brief foot,and quickly dropped back.
