Weight: 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$100,000 twice at a mile or over in 2004 allowed 3 lbs; of \$100,000 at a mile or over in 2004; 6 lbs; of \$100,000 at any distance 9 lbs; of \$50,000 at any distance 12 lbs. (MCOS not considered in weight allowances) The Ohio Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) starters, in the event more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box by 10:30 A.M. Eastern Standard Time, Wednesday June 9, 2004, preference will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the time of closing entries. BRASS HAT steadied a bit behind MAMBO TRAIN entering the first turn then was unhurried while trailing into the second turn, responded readily when asked, angled four wide while rallying to make the lead entering the stretch then drew off the final eighth while being ridden out. POLLARD'S VISION settled just off the leaders for six furlongs, rallied three wide to make the lead near the quarter pole, was quickly headed by the winner, altered course outside that one at the eighth pole then finished second best. TRIESTE'S HONOR also with the pace, assumed command going into the second turn, led until the quarter pole then gradually weakened. DASHBOARD DRUMMER settled well back for a half, offered a mild bid on the second turn then leveled off. MAMBO TRAIN dropped towards the rail entering the first turn then failed to menace. LIMEHOUSE well placed just off the leaders along the inside, also bid on the second turn then came up empty. AVID SKIER broke alertly to set a pressured pace around the first turn, had speed into the second turn then flattened out. JANDEMAR pressed the pace off the rail around the first turn, assumed command before a half then stopped after six furlongs. WATER CANNON was through after a half.
