AFLAIR away alertly, set a pressured pace into the second turn then was no match for the winner. IRISH MIST had a mild late rally. ITS BINALONG TIME outrun for six furlongs, found his best stride too late. GENERAL LAFAYETTE passed tiring rivals. MONTY CAT was through after a half. THISONESFORELMO was no factor. ANDY O close up early, flattened out. YOU BETTER BELIEVE pressed the pace for six furlongs then stopped.
