OLMOSTA was allowed to settle, rallied, at the quarter pole, three wide to quickly draw off, while being ridden out. WEGOTTA stalked the pace, then vied for lead and was outfinished through the stretch but was second best. DIAMOND LAUR was well placed, but lacked a late response and raced evenly. OLYMPIC EXPERIENCE was allowed to settle and passed tiring rivals while no threat. FRISK ME GENTLY was well placed and saved ground but had no rally. IMAMYTO set the pace, then dueled, and gave way in the stretch. NEVER UNDER was no factor.
