PAY THE MAN away alertly, set the pace into the stretch, drifted out a bit, turned back a strong bid by MUIR WOODS at the top of the stretch and prevailed under brisk handling. MUIR WOODS broke outward and was allowed to settle, moved up between horses on the first turn, dropped along the rail while stalking the leaders, got through along the inside when the winner drifted out a bit entering the stretch, drew on even terms for the lead just past the three sixteenths pole then finished second best. THE WAR DEPARTMENT was bumped a few strides out of the gate and held wide into the first turn by ADREAMFORDARLENE, angled in before a quarter, pressured the winner until mid stretch then faded late. ADREAMFORDARLENE came out bumping THE WAR DEPARTMENT a few strides out of the gate, remained wide entering the first turn, offered a mild bid on the second turn then failed to sustain her bid. STARTIN SOMETHING within striking distance from the start, also bid on the second turn then came up empty. HONEY BE FLEET trailed.
