BARBY'S SHAMROCK bobbled a few strides out of the gate, quickly sprinted to the lead, was taken back a bit coming out of the first turn then rated nicely into the far turn, responded three wide to make the lead entering the stretch and won under a drive. CRAFTY CRYPTO also bobbled at the start, settled just off the leaders along the rail, angled three wide entering the stretch and finished second best. IMAHONEYTOO rushed up to make the lead before a quarter, set the pace until the second turn then was outfinished. GALETTE hopped at the start, trailed for over a half then closed ground on the second turn and finished evenly. NATURAL NINE had brief speed. IS IT GOLD failed to menace. GIRLISH GIGGLE raced five wide and was no threat. CALLMEBRANDY had speed for a half then flattened out.
