SEEKING FLIGHT pressed the pace, rallied and gained a clear lead in mid stretch, drifted out in late stretch under left hand pressure forcing WESTERN PIRATE to check then drew clear. WESTERN PIRATE well placed early, rallied five wide in the stretch, steadied in late stretch losing his momentum when SEEKING FLIGHT bore out and was clear for second. OCEAN OF DREAMS contended throughout, finished willing and was best of the rest. YOUNG APOLLO never far back, improved his position while no threat. EL SUPREMO had good position while between horses, faltered in the stretch. LIFEINTHETROPICS was never in contention. WESTERN NIGHT vied for the lead, gave way in the stretch. FAST SUMMER raced four wide and was outrun. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and after viewing the video tape disqualified SEEKING FLIGHT and placed him second for inference in late stretch.
