OUT OF INK settled just off the leaders three wide, went up to draw on even terms for the lead entering the stretch, matched strides to the wire and proved best in a stiff drive. ITS BINALONG TIME never far back, advanced steadily four wide, engaged the leaders at the top of the stretch, battled the balance of the trip and just missed. SKY TAPS prompted the pace two wide for six furlongs, made the lead and dropped along the rail, dug in gamely when joined by the top two at the top of the stretch, maintained command until deep stretch but was outfinished. ELUSIVE FURRARI close up along the rail, weakened the final eighth. POR SUPUESTO set a pressured pace along the rail for six furlongs then gave way. RAILROADED raced widest of all while no factor. PACKER broke in a tangle, ran up on heels entering the first turn then was through after a half.
