Non-Winners of \$100,000 twice at a mile or over in 2003 allowed 3 lbs; of \$100,000 at a mile or over in 2003; 6 lbs; of \$100,000 at any distance 9 lbs; of \$50,000 at any distance 12 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming, Optional or Starter not considered in weight allowances) The Ohio Derby will be limited to fourteen starters, in the event more than fourteen entries pass the entry box by 10:30 A. M. EST, June 18, 2003, preference will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the time of closing entries.

Footnotes

WILD AND WICKED went up to chase the pacesetter HACKENDIFFY soon after the start while to his outside, drew to his flank on the middle of the second turn, gave up a length and one-half then came on again to gain the advantage inside the eighth pole then drew clear under a brisk hand ride. HACKENDIFFY hit the side of the gate at the start, made the lead a few jumps thereafter, sprinted to a clear lead, made the pace to the eighth pole while setting soft fractions, could not handle the winner but was clearly second best. MIDWAY ROAD checked hard on the first turn, while behind PRIVATE CITY and in a box, was allowed to settle, offered a bid on the second turn then finished evenly. CROWNED KING close up around the first turn, gave up some ground down the backstretch, came on again on the second turn then faded. PRIVATE CITY close up, offered a mild bid on the second turn then flattened out. ON THE BORDER was through after a half. MISS KARRY THENEWS trailed throughout.
