WEST LONG BRANCH was away alertly and dueled on the lead, was well handled throughout and prevailed late in a game effort. JUMP BAIL dueled with the winner the entire trip, could not get by him in the stretch, but was clearly second best. DONE DEAL well placed early, rallied in the stretch and finished willingly. DIVINE BUCK allowed to settle, had a late gain while no threat. SEEKING AWARDS stalked the pace, put in a bid at the quarter pole, then flattened out in mid stretch. BAD LITTLE FELLOW slow early, was no factor. WARNER JAZZ MAN had good position for a half, then weakened. TRUE PLATINUM had brief foot and gave way.
