WINNER'S SECRET dueled early, gained a clear lead down the backside and was nicely rated, remained clear in mid stretch just lasted under under strong handling. MEADOW VESPERS was unhurried early, rallied four wide in the upper stretch, closed strongly and just missed. POLITICAL PASSION well placed and saved ground, lacked a late bid and went evenly. KING KITTEN pressed the pace four wide, faded in late stretch. JUST FOR FRANK never far back, steadied at the three eight pole, then lacked a rally. FREEDOM'S HALO allowed to settle, failed to menace. BATTLE MOUNTAIN pressed the pace while between horses, tired on the second turn.
