POWERSTOWN dueled on the lead the entire trip, prevailed after a long drive, gamely. RIKIM dueled with the winner from the inside and just missed in a game try. THE BIG STORY well placed and saved ground, went evenly. HELLO FROM HEAVEN allowed to settle early, swung wide in the stretch and had a mild bid. WOOD ALLEY chased the speed, lacked a late response and went evenly. BLAZING PRIZE checked at the five eighth pole and was no threat. BABA BOEY slow early, did not threaten. ALL FOR LOVE dueled early while coming over quickly from the outside causing a chain reaction of bumping inside, weakened in the stretch. HUNTER'S ROAR was never a threat. The riders of BLAZING PRIZE and HUNTERS ROAR claimed foul for inference down the backside. After viewing the tape the stewards took no action.
