THAT'S SO ROMANTIC allowed to settle for five furlongs, moved up steadily three wide on the second turn, made the lead at the top of the stretch, drew clear and was all out to hold MANDAKINI safe under brisk handling. MANDAKINI had speed from the start, rallied steadily five wide and just missed getting up in time. L'IL MISS SUNSHINE always within striking distance, was steadily gaining ground late. NO EXPOSURE outrun into the stretch, closed a gap late. WILSON TERRACE failed to menace. ANDY'S LILLY prompted the early pace, made the lead after a quarter, set the pace into the stretch then weakened. PENNY'S GLORY was a sharp threat into the stretch then gave way. PAINT MY DREAMS was always outrun. BANYAN TREE set the early pace, had speed into the second turn then stopped.
