MARBLE CLIFF stalked the early pace, rallied on the second turn while three wide, made the lead without being asked, drew off through the stretch to when

as his rider pleased. FORMAL ARRANGEMENT allowed to settle while between horses, rallied through the stretch, was no match for the winner but was clearly second best. ALLSAROTT unhurried early, improved his position but did not threaten the top two. CAJUN PRIZE stalked the pace and saved ground, lacked a late response and went evenly late. OHIO'S WAY allowed to settle, rallied on the second turn with a strong bid, then flattened out in the lane. TYPE A PERSONALITY well placed until the second turn, lacked a late response. STREET KING slow early, passed tiring rivals while no threat. KID'S PRIZE unhurried early, failed to menace. KING CRUZ wide early, was outrun. RED DESERT ANGEL four wide early was no factor. PERFECTLY PLAYED had good position, then weakened in the stretch. DOUBLE HIS DUES pressed the early pace, then dropped back. PYRITE GEM set the pace until the second turn, then gave way. O'RIAIN well placed early, stopped through the stretch.
