Footnotes

SALTY TRICK allowed to settle, finished with a burst of speed while splitting horses late and won under strong handling. NAMESAKE never far back, rallied past leaders four wide entering the stretch, opened a clear lead before the eighth pole then could not handle the winner but finished clear for second. MR PERFECT hopped at the start, settled well back early, then closed some ground late in the middle of the racetrack. DECLARATION went evenly. BEES ON HIGH pressed the pace into the stretch then gave way late. RING READY was a sharp threat into the stretch then came up empty. WEDDING CRASHER was outrun. KEY LOW set a quick pace into the stretch then tired. EMISSARY offered little.
