PRINCESS ZANETA sprinted to the lead shortly after the start, set the balance of the pace and prevailed under strong handling. ROLL PRESLEE ROLL chased the winner all the way and was getting to that one late. HOW'S BAYOU stumbled badly at the start, dropped towards the rail quickly then was steadily gaining ground late along the inside. SUCCULENT SCORE offered a mild bid into the stretch then leveled off. ALLABOUTIMAGE (NZ) well placed, failed to offer a closing response. MANDATEFOREMILY was no factor. ROMA'S GAL had brief speed. ULTIMATE BLISS was no threat. OHIO VOLUNTEER offered little.
